Topic Covered: Internal Exam Evaluation and Examination Pattern

Mrs. Rishita D patel, has introduced Internal exam process and evaluation to newly admitted students with the internal examination structure, evaluation criteria, and academic goals as per institutional and PCI guidelines.

Internal examinations serve as a vital tool to reinforce classroom learning through regular assessments, helping students consolidate their understanding. They also enable educators to identify individual academic strengths and areas needing improvement. Most importantly, these exams prepare students for the rigor and format of university-level final evaluations, fostering confidence and academic discipline.

Key Points Discussed

1. Structure and Frequency

- Internal exams conducted twice per semester, duration and marks and informed about how to calculate round up marks 25, with brief detail about each component.
- Attendance & Detention Policy
- Remedial Theory Exams
- Academic Evaluation Components includes Assignment, student teacher interaction, participate in to cohort activities, 80% attendance etc.
- Includes theory papers and practical assessments

2. Evaluation Criteria

- Theory: Written exams based on syllabus coverage with Q.Paper demonstration and informed about CO, RBL and PO.
- Practical: Performance in lab work, viva voce, and record submission Q.Paper demonstration and informed about CO, RBL and PO.
- Attendance and class participation also considered.

3. Mark Distribution

- Theory: 30 Marks → Final marks 25 and showed conversion of that.
- Practical: 40 marks → Final marks 25.
- Minimum passing criteria and improvement mechanisms explained.

4. Student Responsibilities

- Maintain regular attendance and timely submission of assignments.
- Prepare systematically using syllabus and previous question papers.
- Seek faculty guidance for academic improvement.

5. Institutional Support

- Remedial sessions for academically weak students.
- Transparent communication of exam schedules and results.
- Encouragement of ethical exam practices and self-discipline.

During the interaction, students actively engaged by asking insightful questions regarding exam weightage and the process of re-evaluation. They showed a keen interest in understanding how internal marks contribute to their final academic grades, reflecting their eagerness to align with institutional expectations. The session was well-received, with students expressing appreciation for the clarity and transparency provided in the briefing.

Day 1 – 8th September 2025

- **Role of Pharmacist in Nation-Building** – A motivational session highlighting the importance of pharmacists in healthcare delivery and public health.

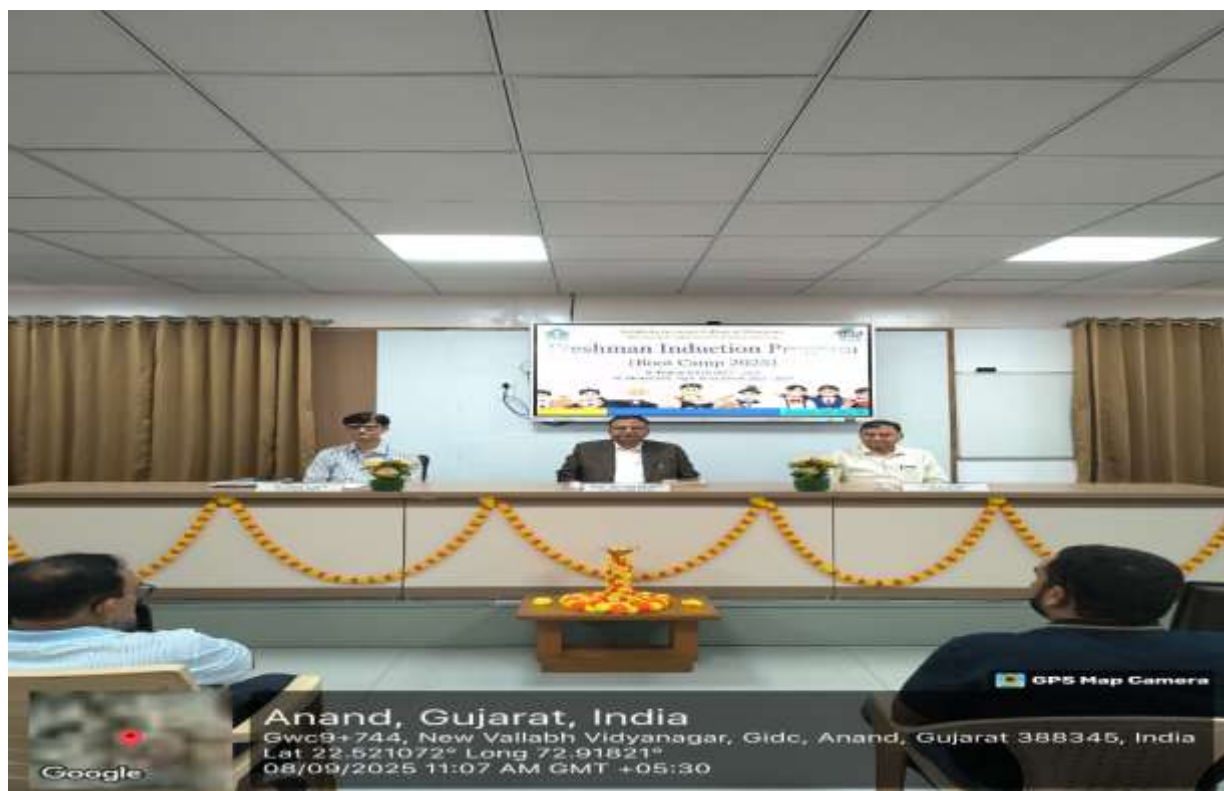
Day 5 – 12th September 2025
